Library Rules and regulations:

Our College Library meant for all the library users to upgrade their own knowledge.

- * The students are allowed to borrow only 6 books at a time
- * The borrowed books can be retained for a period of 15 days. It can be renewed one time only. Failing which, a fine amount of Rs. 1/- per day will be fined.
- * Library Users Should Scan the id Card in the Gate entry before entering and Exiting
- * Reference books and periodicals cannot be taken out from the Library
- * Any damage, loss of page or pictures etc., should be reported to the Library Staffs immediately at the time of borrowing. Damages or any explanation will not be accepted while returning the books
- * Borrowed books should be kept neatly. Marking, Underlining, scribbling or any other damage will be punishable (replacing the new book).
- * Books lost or Damage to books, will have to be paid or replaced. The discretion of the Principal or Librarian in this matter shall be final.
- * Strict Silence should be maintain inside the Library
- * The students are not allowed to bring their own materials like bags, books, notebooks, boxes etc. inside the Library.
- * Books will be issued only after producing the borrower card. Cards are not transferable. Books will be issued only to the ID Card holder and not through anybody else.
- * Students are not permitted to sit in the library during their lecture and practical hours.
- * The Library will not accept responsibility for the loss or misplacement of Personal belongings.



The Andhra Pradesh government and chief minister Mr. Chandrababu Naidu approved Amravati town as the new capital on UGADI(23rd march 2015).The ancient seat of power of Satavahana rulers, as its new capital coming up in the Vijayawada and Guntur region which is also known for its historical and spiritual significance. It is also referred as Amareswaram, for its famous Amareshwara temple for lord Shiva. It was formerly known as “Andhra Nagari”

ATELUGU IMPERIAL CITY:

Ancient and medieval Amaravathi was the centre of Telugu empire for over 1800 years from the second century BC to the 16th century AD, and the political and cultural capital of the Satavahana rulers, Ikshvakus, Eastern Chalukyas, Telugu cholas, The Kota chiefs, Pallavas etc.

TOWN LOCATION:

The city is located on the right bank of the mighty Krishna river in Guntur district, close to where the river joined by its northern tributary, the Munnuru. The new capital city zone is 35 km from old Amaravathi, where the government has procured nearly 33,000 acres between Vijayawada and Guntur.

AMELTING POINT OF RELIGIONS:

Amaravathi was seat of Buddhism before the rise of Satavahanas, a stupa and monastery having been built during there during the reign of Emperor Ashoka(269-232BC).The Satavahanas patronized Hinduism, and the ancient temple of Amaralingeshwara(Shiva) gave the city name Amararamam, later it emerged as AMARAVATHI. Subsequent dynasties patronized Jainism as well, and the city came to be known as Sridhanyakataka or 'city of tolerance'.





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
