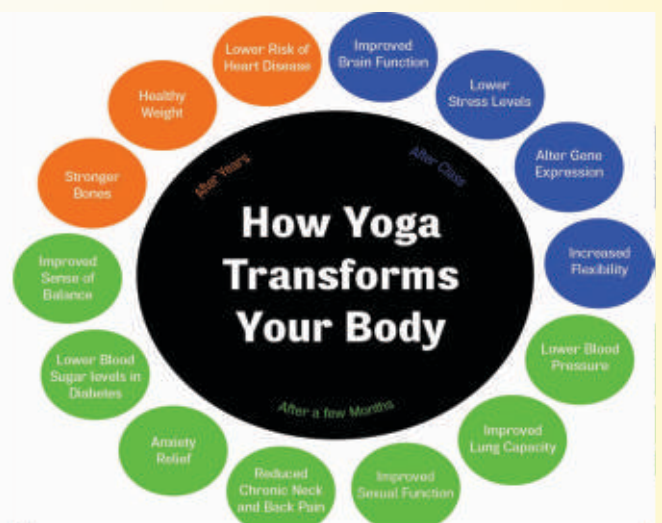

# Celebration of Doctors' Day

First of July has been designated as Doctors' Day in India. It is indeed important that both doctors and patients be made aware of the existence of this day and at the same time, of its relevance and significance in the larger context of healthcare in this country.

Here is a little history as to why doctors' day is celebrated on this particular day.

**Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy** was born on July 1, 1882 at Bankipore in Patna in Bihar. His career as a physician started in 1911 when he came back to India from Bartholomew's hospital in the UK having completed his MRCP. Thereafter, he joined the teaching staff of Calcutta Medical College and later moved to Campbell Medical School and then to Carmichael Medical College. He dedicated his life to the upliftment of Indian society, especially, the downtrodden.

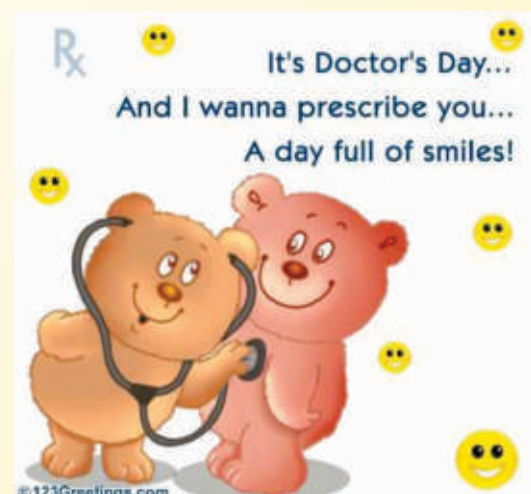
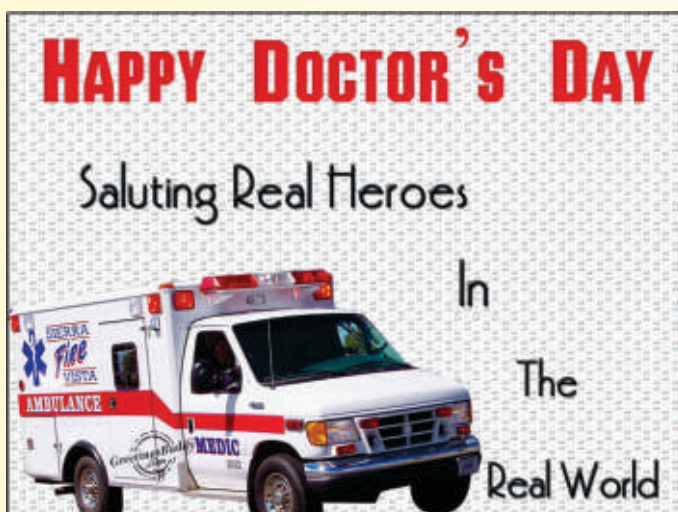
Not only did he excel as a physician, he was an educationist, social reformer, freedom fighter (joined Mahatma Gandhi in the Civil Disobedience movement), leader of Indian National Congress and later chief minister of West Bengal. Dr B C Roy passed away on July 1, 1962 on his birthday.

Thus July 1st was considered an appropriate day to be designated as **Doctors' Day**- a tribute to Dr B C Roy and the entire medical profession.

On 1<sup>st</sup> of July S. B. Devi Charity Home had celebrated this special day by serving the ailing humanity by health check-up. This program was organized in association with Rotary Club of North Calcutta and North East Calcutta Social & Welfare Organization.

A total number of 110 patients were checked in the camp. General screening was done to assess their health status. Individuals who were found to have any clinical problem were guided for treatment under proper clinician's supervision at S. B. Devi Charity Home. Those who were nutritionally deficient or obese assessed by their BMI were given proper counselling to overcome the situation.

The society owes a debt of gratitude to physicians for their contributions in enlarging the reservoir of scientific knowledge, increasing the number of scientific tools, and expanding the ability of professionals to use the knowledge and tools effectively in the never ending fight against disease and death. The society also owes a debt of gratitude to physicians for the sympathy and compassion of physicians in administering the sick and alleviating human suffering. On this day the common people take the opportunity to thank all doctors all over the world.

# WINDOWS 10

**Windows 10** is a personal computer operating system being developed by Microsoft as part of the Windows NT family of operating systems.

Windows 10 introduces revisions to the operating system's user interface, including the addition of Start menu similar to Windows 7 but incorporating Windows 8's "live tiles", a virtual desktop system, a notifications sidebar, and the ability to adjust user interface behaviors based on available input devices

## Features

A major aspect of Windows 10 is a focus on harmonizing user experiences and functionality between different classes of devices, along with addressing shortcomings in the Windows user interface that were introduced in Windows 8. Continuing with this pattern, the successor to Windows Phone 8.1 unveiled at the same event is also branded as Windows 10, and will share some user interface elements and apps with its PC counterpart.

The Windows Store app ecosystem has been revised into "Windows apps". They are made to run across multiple platforms and device classes, including smartphones, tablets, Xbox One consoles, and other compatible Windows 10 devices. Windows apps share code across platforms, have responsive designs that adapt to the needs of the device and available inputs, can synchronize data between Windows 10 devices (including notifications, credentials, and allowing cross-platform multiplayer for games), and will be distributed through a unified Windows Store. Developers can allow "cross-buys", where purchased licenses for an app apply to all of the user's compatible devices, rather than only the one they purchased on (i.e. a user purchasing an app on PC is also entitled to use the smartphone version at no extra cost).

Windows 10 will also allow web apps and desktop software (using either Win32 or .NET Framework) to be packaged for distribution on the Windows Store. Desktop software distributed through Windows Store will be packaged using the App-V system to allow sandboxing.

## System requirements

The basic hardware requirements to install Windows 10 are the same as for Windows 8.1. Devices running a compressed operating system (including some 32 GB devices and all 16 GB devices) or PCs using older 64-bit CPUs may not be supported.

# Woman in Technology

A high-school outreach program first brought "**Tamara Broderick**" to MIT in 2002. Now she's back, as an assistant professor in EECS. Leda Zimmerman | School of Engineering June 29, 2015

Tamara Broderick's career at MIT started when she was still in high school. In 2002, she participated in the inaugural class of MIT's Women's Technology Program (WTP) — a new experiment at the time that brought high school girls to campus for a four-week program designed to spark a passion for engineering and computer science. She arrived on campus that summer from Cleveland, Ohio, thrilled at the prospect of an immersion in science and math. "WTP was an amazing opportunity to learn the basics of computer science, electrical engineering, and applied math with like-minded peers," she says. "I felt I was suddenly in a place where I really belonged. "Now the ITT Career Development Assistant Professor in the Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, Broderick recalls "open-ended projects that pushed frontiers for me," such as biopsying a grape suspended in Jell-O with a homemade Lego-based probe.

There was extracurricular fun as well with a "group of people who shared the same nerdy sensibility." She saw the Boston Pops, ate her first dim sum, and drew the digits of pi on a beach. But most of all Broderick credits WTP with demonstrating the potential of computer science and mathematics as fields of study. "My experience at WTP was formative," she says. "It had a broad impact on what I wanted to do, in my decision to pursue math and computer science more generally. Broderick set out to learn more about physics, math, and computer science, earning a BA in mathematics from Princeton University in 2007. She went on to earn a master of advanced study in mathematics in 2008 and an MPhil in physics in 2009 at Cambridge University. While on a Marshall Scholarship in the UK, Broderick discovered Bayesian statistics. "A lot of my interests coalesced," she says. She then came back to the U.S. in 2009, to the University of California at Berkeley, to begin a master's in computer science (which she completed in 2013) and a PhD in statistics, which she earned in 2014.

Her doctoral work in machine learning involved developing algorithms that can speed computational analysis of large, streaming data sets, enabling computers to discover more and more hidden and meaningful structure in data as more data is obtained — without the need for prior human annotation.

Though Broderick describes her work as primarily theoretical, it is already lending itself to useful and surprising applications. One of her algorithms has been deployed to analyze tumor heterogeneity. Different types of cancer may appear in a single tumor, and identifying the disparate yet connected types of diseased tissue may speed a more targeted treatment approach. This algorithm and the theory behind it was the work Broderick presented at MIT in 2013 during another recruitment program devoted to increasing gender diversity, Rising Stars.
